Wheel of fortune: we needed 1200 bags of rocks. We had 600 when all tumbled rocks bagged. Spent every night of the week painting rocks. Painted rocks went really well. Will need 1200 bags rocks and painted rocks by February. Tumbling rocks needed and tumbling done. Leah and Marv used to tumble 70 + pounds of rocks and we do not have that luxury any more.

T Shirts: Didn't sell t shirts. Mostly to club members. Liquidate remaining shirts. Need to consider other options.

Awards: Wrong order. Need to have awards before raffle and the people's choice ballots counted and the best of show case chosen before 3:30 on Sunday.
